

HELP PUT WALKING ON THE GENERAL ELECTION AGENDA

When we design streets for children, we create places that work better for everyone. More people walking and wheeling means safer streets, better health and cleaner air.



As the General Election approaches, candidates and campaigners from all parties may knock on your door canvassing for your vote. If you want your incoming MP to prioritise safer streets, then this is your chance to let them know.



HOW TO USE YOUR DOOR HANGER

1. Print, cut down the dotted line and fold the hanger in half, then cut out the circles.
2. Tick what would make your local streets safer and better for walking/wheeling.
3. Hang on the outside/inside of your front door - depending on the weather!
4. When canvassers visit, it's on hand to let them know what you want.
5. Show any issues on your street and tell them about Living Streets' campaign.

SHOW AND TELL

Use the reverse to show people canvassing what improvements are needed in your neighbourhood.



And tell them:

SHOW AND TELL

Select the changes you would like to see to your local streets.

- Slower traffic speeds**
- Safer/more crossing points**
- Clearer pavements**
- Less congestion/traffic**
- No pavement parking**
- Places to stop and rest**
- Better maintained pavements**
